## INTRODUCTION TO THE TRUST

Akash Memorial Charitable Trust was established on 24 Sep 2005. The trust has been formed in the memory of Akash Saxena, an outstanding human being and student of computer engineering from National Institute of Technology, Jalandhar, whose brilliant life was cut short by an unfortunate accident at an early age of twenty years. The trust is registered under the Indian Registration Act vide Registration No.IV/349 dated 24.09.2005.

## OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST

- To provide medical relief to the needy.
- To provide education, scholarships and render aid to students, like supply of books, stipend, meals and other incentives to study.
- To establish, maintain or grant aid to homes for aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows and aged persons.
- To grant relief and assistance to the needy victims during natural calamities and man made disasters like terrorist attack etc.

- To provide training (vocational, personality development, civic sense etc).
- To provide basic amenities to the poor people.
- For advancement of any other object or objects that are legally charitable and of general public utility.

## ACTIVITIES OF THE TRUST

### Donations

Since its inception, the trust has donated to institutes like SOS Children's Village (India), Cancer Aid and Research Foundation, Mumbai and Ram Krishna Vivekananda Mission. The trust has provided medical equipment (Infra-Red Ray Lamps) to Delhi Cheshire Home for destitute who cannot afford such treatment.

### Adoption of Orphans

The trust has adopted a girl named Nupur and a boy named Ulhas of SOS children village, Faridabad since 2005. The trust takes care of all round development of these children through sponsorship of education, medical and food.

### Assistance for Victims of Calamities

The trust has provided assistance to the victims of the massive earthquake in J & K in

Oct 2005, by donating blankets, clothes, medicines and food items.

### Monetary Assistance for Education

The trust has also taken up the responsibility of monetary assistance for education of poor children.

- A rolling trophy with monetary remuneration for outstanding performance in mathematics in class X is instituted at Air Force Bal Bharti School, Lodhi Road, New Delhi.
- A trophy with remuneration is awarded to a student of primary wing of the same school, for achievements in extra curricular activities.
- A poor student named Pradeep, belonging to Scheduled Caste from UP was provided financial assistance for admission in a private engineering college.

### Help in Social Causes

- The trust has been instrumental in solemnizing the marriage of a poor couple by providing financial assistance.
- The trust has institutionalized provision of one meal to poor and disabled people through Missionaries of Charity, Delhi, at their location (Majnu ka Tila, New Delhi).
